CHALLENGE GAMES

FOR ARLINGTON PREMIER INVITATIONAL AND PLANO PREMIER TEAMS

To provide an opportunity for the top two division one teams in U11 – U17 from both the API and PPI leagues to challenge into the CCSAI Classic League, there will be a challenge held at the North America Memorial Day Cup at the end of May. The following is the information and format that will be used for eligibility to be invited to the challenge games:

1. The top two (2) division one (1) U11 – U17 teams based on full year standings from both the API and PPI leagues will be considered for invitation. A record of team misconducts will also be reviewed on the teams for consideration of the team's invitation from the Classic League.
2. Full year standings will be for both the fall and spring seasons combined with only points earned from win-loss-tie records. No additional league standing points will be considered. League play for both seasons must have parity within the division considering like opponents. For example, a sixteen team division may play each team once in the fall. In the spring the top eight from the fall standings may play in the top division. Only those top eight would be eligible to finish as one of the top two to be considered for invitation based on both the fall and spring standing points combined.
3. All league tiebreakers will be applied in case of any team division ties.
4. Teams may only use their rostered players as of April 1, 2010 for the challenge.
5. Teams must play in their age appropriate division for qualification. For example, U17 teams playing in the U19 age group for league play must participate in the U17 challenge group, not U19 to be eligible for qualification.
6. The format will be the top two (2) teams from API and PPI and the 9th and 10th place Classic League Division Three (3) teams for a six (6) team challenge group. Round robin play with the six teams will be used. After the round robin play the top two teams will qualify for an invitation to fill the 2 Bye positions in Division Three (3) for the following soccer year in U12 – U19 of CCSAI Classic League and this invitation will be extended to the club of that qualifying team.
7. The challenge games will be held at the North America Memorial Day Cup the last weekend of May. Entry fee will be \$600.00 per team to cover the cost of referees, fields, and administration. Games will be included as a separate bracket in the tournament format so any misconducts recorded will only be for this competition. No advancement or awards will be provided for these games in the tournament.

At the conclusion of spring league play, each league will notify the CCSAI Classic League of their final full year division one (1) standings and record of team misconducts for their top two teams. The Classic League will then send application information to the teams for the challenge games.
